

Checklist for EU citizens

What I need to work legally as a sex worker in Austria:

- Meldezettel: Within three days, I have to report my residence in Austria
- Within one month I have to register myself at the tax office
- Within one month I have to register myself at the Social Insurance Institution (SVS)
- Registration certificate (Anmeldebescheinigung): If I'm staying through three months in Austria I need to apply for a registration certificate
- Every six weeks I have to be tested at the Health Department, so that my health card remains valid

What to do in the case of violence?

- Nobody is allowed to force me into prostitution or sexual practices. Nobody is allowed to threaten me or my family, or use violence against me
- Police Emergency: 133

Safer Sex

- A condom protects me from sexually transmitted diseases
